Registration and Fees:

We ask you to complete an Annual Registration Form. This information will help us to look after your child's well-being whilst at Trinitots and to provide you with information about our activities. We won't share this information without your consent, except in circumstances required by law, or to safeguard a child or adult. We'll keep your information secure and keep it only for as long as is necessary for our operational needs.

When you first arrive, please sign in (this is used as a register in case of evacuation), and park your buggy in the area provided downstairs. Fees for 2021/2022 remain at £1.50 with 50p for an additional child. This helps to provide refreshments, equipment and activities. Please speak to Val or Sharon if this is difficult for you.

Topics:

Each half term we follow a topic, looking at a different aspect each week. Children are given a sticker card and may collect a weekly sticker. We also produce a newsletter each half term. We encourage you to help them think about our topics when you are out and about.

Safety:

At the moment, we have space for 15 children with their grownups. Please ensure that you book your place on Eventbrite, the details of which will be emailed out each week. Unfortunately, we do not allow school age children on Training Days etc.

Although every care will be taken to ensure the safety of the children at Trinitots, they remain the responsibility of their grownups at all times. Please be aware that there may be other users of the facilities in the building. Our leaders are DBS checked and are trained in Safeguarding, First Aid and Food Safety.

If you spot a toy or piece of equipment that is damaged or soiled, please let us know.

We would be grateful if mobile phone use could be minimised.

No photographs should be taken during the sessions for safeguarding reasons. We have a closed Facebook group - *Trinitots @Bramley* where we post information and pictures that we have taken which have been approved for posting on this group page only.

Photos should not be copied and reposted anywhere else.

Nappy changing facilities are available at the top of the staircase. Please take soiled nappies away with you.

Snacks:

During snack time we encourage children to sit down and share together. If your child has allergies, please make this clear on the registration form, so that we can help. Drinks and snacks are also provided for adults, please drink hot drinks in the designated area and keep lids on the cups to avoid accidents. Please take care to clear away after your child (or ask them to help).

We hope you enjoy your time with us, if you feel unsure of anything, please ask someone - we are here to help. **Val and Sharon.**
